

U.S. Measles Cases, 2026

- There continues to be no confirmed cases of measles in Massachusetts
- A total of 2,267 measles cases were reported by 45 jurisdictions in 2025. 93% of cases were unvaccinated or unknown. There were 3 confirmed deaths.
- For 2026, 733 measles cases have been reported by 20 jurisdictions. 93% of cases were unvaccinated or unknown.

Measles Update

- On January 23rd, 2026, the WHO announced **six European countries lost their measles elimination status**: Armenia, Austria, Azerbaijan, Spain, the UK, and Uzbekistan. Canada lost their elimination status in 2025.
 - CDC recommends that all travelers be fully vaccinated against measles before traveling to **any** international destination.
- **Elimination status in US:** Currently under threat and being reviewed.
 - Measles was [officially eliminated from the United States in 2000](#), meaning there is no measles spreading within the country and new cases are only found when someone contracts measles abroad and returns to the country. Achieving measles elimination status in the United States was a historic public health achievement.
- **Domestic Outbreaks of interest:** Texas, Utah, South Carolina

Traveling While Measles is Circulating

- For International Travel (or Domestic Travel to a community outbreak):
 - All international travelers should be fully vaccinated against measles with the measles-mumps-rubella (MMR) vaccine, according to CDC's measles vaccination recommendations for international travel, including:
 - a total of two doses at least 28 days apart for anyone 12 months old or older without adequate evidence of immunity
 - an early dose for infants 6–11 months old

Electronic Case Reporting (eCR) in MA

- eCR messages contain electronic health record (EHR) data from a medical encounter
- MA receives an eCR if a patient encounter meets criteria for MA reportable condition(s)
- eCR is a national program - MA receives eCR for individuals seen in other states and vice versa
- Clinical and laboratory information relevant to the condition is sent to MAVEN
- Approximately 10% of reportable cases currently contain eCR data (and growing)



- eCR Reportable Condition
- eCR Reporting Healthcare Organization
- eCR Race & eCR Hispanic
- Visit Date*
- Gender Identity
- Medications
 - Rx, start/end date, dose, form, route
- Diagnoses (and diagnosis date)
- Symptoms (and onset date)
- Laboratory tests
 - Test, result, result value, received date, [specimen info when available]

**Visit Date child questions:*

- *Reason for visit (if coded)*
- *Pregnancy*
 - *Status, determination date, EDD, outcome of pregnancy (if sent)*
- *Did patient die?*
- *Occupation & Industry (if sent)*
- *Was case hospitalized?*
 - *Facility, Admission/Discharge dates*
- *Facility name, type, and contact information (for reported visit)*
- *Provider name and contact information (for reported visit)*
