### **Key Terms**

- **DFP** =  $\underline{D}$ ivision of  $\underline{F}$ ood  $\underline{P}$ rotection at DPH (formerly FPP)
- **FBI** = <u>F</u>ood<u>b</u>orne <u>I</u>llness
- $\mathbf{QP} = \mathbf{Q}$ uestion  $\mathbf{p}$ ackage
- Complainant = Individual reporting illness and exposure information (the ill individual, a medical provider, etc.)
- METRIK = local public health data solution being developed by the DPH Office of Local and Regional Health (OLRH)

# Foodborne Illness Complaint Reporting

### First off: What hasn't changed

#### **General FBI Complaint Guidance**

- ✓ Create an FBI complaint event for both in-state <u>and</u> out-of-state food exposures. Out-of-country exposures do not need to be included.
- ✓ Only one FBI complaint event needs to be created per person or per party.
- ✓ Multiple food exposures for an individual or party can be entered into a single foodborne illness complaint event.

### DPH recommends creating an FBI complaint event in MAVEN when:

#### Undiagnosed



An undiagnosed individual with gastrointestinal illness reports one or more of the following in the 7 days before symptom onset:

- ✓ Eating food prepared outside of a private residence
- ✓ Consuming one of the following **high-risk foods**:
  - Unpasteurized milk, unpasteurized and unaged (<6 months) cheese, unpasteurized juice or cider, or raw shellfish or seafood
- ✓ Consuming food at an event or gathering where others are also sick

### Diagnosed



A diagnosed enteric disease case reports one or more of the following during their incubation period:

- ✓ Eating food prepared outside of a private residence
- ✓ Consuming one of the following high-risk foods: Unpasteurized milk, unpasteurized and unaged (<6 months) cheese, unpasteurized juice or cider, or raw seafood or shellfish
- ✓ Is an infant that is primarily formula fed.
- $\checkmark$  Consuming food at an event or gathering where others are also sick





### **Recap of METRIK**

<u>METRIK</u> is a local public health data solution under development by the DPH Office of Local and Regional Health (OLRH) in conjunction with local and state public health professionals.

- METRIK will include tools to support food establishment inspections and response to foodborne illness complaints.
- Information from foodborne illness complaint events in MAVEN will be electronically transmitted to METRIK for follow up by LBOH inspectors
- Will reduce manual sharing of information between MAVEN users and inspectors (generally not on MAVEN)
- Expected: 2026


- Online system for reporting suspected foodborne illness to public health officials in MA

- Developed for use by general public and LBOH users not on MAVEN





### Review of MAVEN Updates

### **BEFORE: Jurisdiction before August 2025 MAVEN update**

"Jurisdiction," in the context of MAVEN, refers to assigning a city or town to an event in MAVEN. This is associated with what information (e.g., which events) a LBOH user can see in MAVEN.

- LBOH jurisdiction was <u>not</u> automatically assigned
- FBI complaint events were accessible to a LBOH MAVEN user only if:
  - They are the one who created the FBI complaint event
  - The FBI complaint event was shared with them or their user group
- Note: DFP may not have shared a complaint if inspectional follow up was not recommended (exposure outside of incubation period, took place >4 weeks ago)




### **Important**

Both <u>city</u> and <u>state</u> fields must be completed for official city to populate (and jurisdiction to be assigned)

### NOW: Jurisdiction after August 2025 MAVEN update


An LBOH MAVEN user has access to a foodborne illness (FBI) complaint event if:




A given LBOH that meets the above criteria will have access to the full FBI complaint event (not just information pertaining to the ill person or food establishment in their jurisdiction).


### **Jurisdiction = Access**

- ✓ Timely access (no waiting for event to be shared with you)
- ✓ Improved access to historic events
- ✓ Ability to extract more complete data from MAVEN
- ✓ New FBI complaint workflow!





### **Top of Administrative Question Package**

Bottom line: New fields, but not anything you need to do with them.



Once the electronic transmission is established with METRIK, these fields will populate with a time stamp indicating when information was transmitted to METRIK.



MAVEN user creating an FBI complaint event should complete "Complaint Source"




This will populate with a unique identifier when individuals report illness using the new online report form. LBOHs can ignore this field.




<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> A **complete food exposure** includes all of the following: 1) suspect food, drink, or meal; 2) name of establishment where food was obtained; 3) location of where food was obtained; and 4) when food was consumed (exact date or approximation).

- Variable created to allow us to filter out certain FBI complaint events without deleting them, including:
  - Duplicates
  - Incomplete complaints
  - Invalid complaints
- Added in anticipation that there may be an increase in non-valid complaints with new online reporting


<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup>The **time period of interest** is listed at the top of the Risk/Exposure/Control & Prevention question package of enteric disease events. It often is the incubation period for the pathogen, but may vary (e.g., the incubation period for salmonellosis is 6 hours to 6 days, but the widely used time period for evaluating exposures is 7 days).

### **Top of Complaint Information Question Package**




This field was added to assist with data collected using the online system for reporting (Report My Meal) but can be completed for any complaint.

### FBI complaint information complete?

- LBOH staff entering an FBI complaint event should use this field to indicate if all information expected has been documented (complete), or if more information is expected (information pending)
- DFP may wait to review and provide a follow up recommendation until information is complete

### Two categories for ill individuals

Individual <u>with</u> an enteric disease event you can access in MAVEN

Includes individuals who have:


• **Diagnosed illness**: Sought medical attention and had lab testing performed that was reported

Individual <u>without</u> an enteric disease event you can access in MAVEN

Includes individuals who have:

- Undiagnosed illness: Didn't seek medical attention and/or didn't have lab testing performed
- Diagnosis pending: Lab testing was performed but result is pending
- Diagnosis not reportable:
   Received a diagnosis but it is not a reportable condition

### For Diagnosed Illness (Individual with an Enteric Disease Event in MAVEN)



If the ill individual has an enteric disease event in MAVEN (that you have access to/can confirm):

Enter four pieces of demographic and clinical information from the disease event: name, diagnosis, city, onset date

**AND** 

Link disease event(s) to FBI complaint event



### Requesting assistance from DPH to create a complaint

If you are unable to create an FBI complaint event after interviewing a diagnosed enteric disease case, the disease event can be tasked to the "State – DFP Notification" group and DFP will assist in making an FBI complaint event if one is needed.

- **Type**: Assignment
- **Description**: Add a description of your request
- Notes: Indicate which exposure(s) warrant an FBI complaint event
- **Assign to group**: Select "State DFP Notification" from the drop-down list
- Status and Priority can remain the default values.



### For illness without an enteric disease event in MAVEN

- Includes ill individuals who are undiagnosed (never sought medical attention), have a diagnosis pending, or received a diagnosis that is not reportable
- Collect complete demographic and clinical information for each ill individual:

	Demographic	Name, address, age, gender identity
	Contact	Phone number, email, contact preferences including language spoken
<b>(+)</b>	Illness	Onset date, symptoms, hospitalization, medical attention, diagnosis

### Entering an illness without a disease event


Additional questions will populate after indicating the individual does <u>not</u> have an associated disease event in MAVEN.

- New question to match online system for reporting (Report My Meal)
- Should be completed for all individuals without a disease event in MAVEN (regardless of how complaint received)







### **Top of Food History Question Package**

Improved guidance on how to obtain food history information and what should be documented in the Food History question package.





After entering a suspect food, drink or meal, the "Add New" button will appear that will allow you to enter additional food exposures.




### **DPH-Notify Inspectional Services**


- DPH completes this for every complaint with complete information.
- Only DPH should complete this variable.






#### What's all this stuff about METRIK?





- Once a connection is established, these two fields have the ability to trigger the transmission of FBI complaint data to METRIK.

#### LBOH fields

- Two optional fields that can be used by LBOHs
  - If used, should be the LBOH of the listed food establishment completing them.
- LBOH Reviewed in MAVEN
  - Can be used for LBOH tracking to indicate that the exposure has been reviewed
- LBOH Notify Inspectional Services (optional)
  - As noted in previous slide, this will transmit FBI complaint data to METRIK once a connection is established

#### "Foodborne" illnesses can be transmitted other ways

- Only for illnesses without a MAVEN disease event
- Quickly evaluate other high-risk sources of transmission, including:
  - Waterborne: drinking water, recreational water (e.g., swimming)
  - Animal contact
  - **Person-to-person**: contact with others ill, congregate care settings, large gatherings



#### **Outbreak Response**


- Not a new question package, but not previously visible to LBOH MAVEN users
  - LBOH MAVEN users now have read-only access
- Used by DPH to:
  - Track outbreak investigation activities
  - Document meeting minutes from the <u>Working Group on Foodborne</u> <u>Illness Control (WGFIC)</u>




This field is completed by DFP and is used to distinguish an FBI complaint that reports illness among a single person or household from a suspect foodborne illness outbreak.

**Yes** = routine investigation **No** = outbreak investigation

#### When Single Incident = "No" (Indicates Outbreak)



#### **Generating the Report**

With an FBI complaint event open, click "Print Event" from the left-hand menu



#### **Print options**

- 1) EventPrint.jsp: Prints out all available data in the event (does not print out fields that are not complete).

  DPH does not recommend using this for sharing information with inspectors, as it contains more information than is necessary. Minimally necessary information should be shared with non-MAVEN users, and between jurisdictions.
- **2) FBI\_Complaint\_Report\_For\_Inspector\_PDF\_Document.xml**: Prints out 2-page document for handing off to LBOH inspectional staff. Report contains minimally necessary information for inspectional follow up.
- **3) FBI\_Complaint\_Report\_PDF\_Document.xml**: This is the same as the middle option (#2), but with a DPH Fax cover page included.

#### What populates in the workflow?

- Workflow name: LBOH Foodborne Illness (FBI) Complaint Notification
- Workflow purpose: notification (not to track follow up)
- Any FBI complaint that lists your jurisdiction in either of the following fields will appear in the workflow:



Complaints in the workflow may not require further action by your jurisdiction.

#### How do complaints move in and out of the workflow?






•	To enter workflow	All newly created FBI complaint events enter the workflow. An LBOH user will be able to see all complaints associated with their jurisdiction(s).
<b>(</b>	To exit workflow	FBI complaint events leave this workflow <u>two weeks</u> after they are created.  There is not a field in MAVEN that an LBOH user can complete that will remove an FBI complaint event from this workflow or keep it there for longer than two weeks.



#### **Food History Question Package**

- **FBI Complaint Status** (Admin QP): This is assigned by DFP using the following criteria: FBI Complaint Status Classification
- **Single Incident?** (Outbreak Response QP): This field is completed by DFP and is used to distinguish an FBI complaint that reports illness among a single person or household from a suspect foodborne illness outbreak.
  - "No" indicates that the complaint event is being investigated as an outbreak by the <u>Working Group on Foodborne Illness Control</u> at DPH in conjunction with associated LBOH(s).

#### Understanding variables in the workflow

- **FBI Complaint Information Complete?** (Complaint QP): Completed by the individual reporting the complaint and updated as needed by LBOH or DPH MAVEN users.
- Assigned to Group (Task): If DFP has tasked a complaint event to an LBOH user group because information needs to be communicated to inspectional staff, the city/town name will appear here.

#### Workflow example

#### I am a LBOH PHN in **Cambridge**. This is what my workflow looks like:

#### What this could mean:

- There is one complaint tasked to Cambridge, indicating that the information in that FBI complaint event needs to go to Cambridge inspectors for follow up.
- Other complaints in the workflow may include an ill Cambridge resident or may list a Cambridge food establishments that do not warrant follow up.

#### A note

- It was not possible to include food establishment name and/or location in the workflow
  - It is a repeatable field, and only the first food exposure would appear, which could be misleading if multiple exposures are listed in the Food History QP


# Responding to a Complaint in Your Jurisdiction

#### How a LBOH will be notified of a complaint

- DFP will task a MAVEN LBOH user group if inspectional follow up is recommended for a food establishment listed within an FBI complaint event.
  - Tasking generates an email notification with the MAVEN ID to users in that group
- Event will populate in your workflow(s) for review:
  - My Groups' Open Tasks
  - LBOH Foodborne Illness (FBI) Complaint Notification


#### Acknowledge receipt of complaint - optional

- Within the food history section, if you are the LBOH where the establishment is located you can:
  - Document if you have reviewed the reported food exposure
  - Indicate if you want your own jurisdiction's inspectional services notified.



#### Notify your inspectional staff

- If you took in the original complaint, you will be responsible for notifying your own inspectional staff.
- If you receive a complaint via a task that was completed by another jurisdiction, review the task and notify your inspectional staff.



#### Not sure who to contact?

- Use your jurisdiction's Communication Event in MAVEN to identify contact information for environmental health (inspectional) staff in your city or town.
  - For more information, see: <u>Environmental Health Contacts in MAVEN</u>
- Keep this information up to date if there are changes in staffing.
- DPH uses the Environmental Health Contacts section when making specific inspection follow up requests.

#### Inspectional follow up for complaints


- Follow-up might vary across jurisdictions per internal procedures.
- In accordance with the <u>Foodborne Illness Investigation and Control Manual Chapter 4</u>, it is recommended that some level of investigation should be done for a single possible case of foodborne illness.
- Unless a specific request is made, no information is needed to be returned to DPH, but any documents collected or generated during follow up may be attached to the MAVEN event for record keeping.

### Data Extract

#### **Extracting FBI complaint data from MAVEN**

 There is now a report available to LBOHs to extract question package data: FBI Complaints - Event Information Extract

Previously, LBOHs did not have a way to extract FBI complaint data



#### FBI complaint events exported in extract

- Any complaint that an LBOH user has access to will appear in the extract
- You will have access to a complaint if your city/town is listed in:


